Open Felting Lab – A Magic Day of Making Felt!

This is an opportunity to work with innovative or new felting projects, to make a special piece from the warmth of felted fabric for your personal use or as a treasured gift.

You can start something new, or carry on with a project from an earlier workshop.
Or just join for a day of making magic with felt.

Make a hat or a bag, a vessel or journal cover, a cozy felt neckwrap or pulsewarmers.

The class will be small so there will be time for discussion and guidance in the process in this open class.

Give me a call, we can discuss possibilities and plans for the day. It will be a day of color and wool, surrounded by inspirations of others and your own spirit of adventure.

Course Fee: \$140 plus GST and \$25 Material Fee

- Includes homemade lunch, coffee/tea & biscuits, and all materials.

- Small classes of up to 8 students
- Bring a friend! Your friend will receive a 20% reduction in course fees.
- Weekday Classes: 9.30 am – 4.30 pm

This class can be extended to a two-day felting lab upon special request with a minimum of 3 participants.

What To Bring:

- Sketchbook
- Several old towels
- Bucket
- Large sponge
- Sharp scissors
- Pair of hand carders (optional)
- Embellishments: needles, spools of threads, beads and novelty yarns in a variety of colors and textures
- To augment materials provided you may choose to bring a small bag of special bits and pieces of interesting fabric scraps, even recycled fabrics, with an open enough weave to blow through - fine cottons, silk, organza, chiffon, gauze, hand painted, printed or solid colors, crepes or lacey open knits are easiest to felt. Also, larger remnants in a preferred color theme may add your personal touch. (Synthetic fabric with a strong sheen and smooth surface won't work!)

Art You Wear Workshop Policies

Workshop Cost is including a gourmet lunch, coffee, tea and goodies, plus a basic material fee. Full payment in advance is required to secure your booking on a first come first served basis. The number of students to a Workshop is generally 6 to a maximum of 8.

Within the Studio space there is a large inspirational collection of books, and Gallery containing many samples of my work for inspiration purposes and/or purchase. The Studio is located in a lovely woodland garden setting.

Exotic Materials are available for use during a Workshop at an additional fee. Assorted supply kits are available for purchase at any time.

My goal is to provide the most memorable experience possible in my Workshops. I make a substantial investment when planning them, and vacancies can be hard to fill even if there is a waiting list. If you cancel any time up to 14 days before the beginning of a Workshop, your entire fee will be refunded. If cancellation is received less than 14 days before the Workshop, 50% of the Workshop fee will be non-refundable if I cannot fill your spot.

If a Workshop is cancelled for any reason by myself, all fees will be completely refunded.
